Itinerary:

9:00 – 10:30 – Arrive and visit [CMA Volvo of Charlottesville](#). Coffee and donuts.

9:45am - Driver Muster, appointment of flight leaders. Synchronization of FRS 2-way radios. All drivers must have a FRS radio.

10:30 – 11:00 - Drive to [Chile's Peach Orchard](#)

11:00 – 11:30 Experience [Chile's Peach Orchard](#). There is fun peach and other related food to buy and bring including a shopping opportunity

11:30 – 12:00- Drive to [Stable Craft Brewery](#) where folks will find more good food, wine and beer and a bit of souvenir shopping

12:00 – 1:15- Lunch at [Stable Craft Brewery](#)

1:14 – 1:45- Drive to [Blue Ridge Tunnel East Entrance](#)

1:45 – 3:15 – Experience the [Blue Ridge Tunnel](#) and hike to work off previously consumed calories. All flat, bring a flashlight.

3:15 – 3:45- Drive to [Hazy Mountain Vineyard](#) that includes beautiful views, good wine and good food. They have a large capacity for visitors.

Although the route is fixed, deviate as your heart desires. You must arrive at the final destination on time. The long weather forecast predicts clear skies, sunny and cool days. This is perfect touring weather.

Notice:

Communication between vehicles will be via FRS radio. Drivers must have a FRS hand held 2-way radio. Any FRS (Family Service Radio) is adequate. Bring a USB style charger with 12 volt car adapter for your radio. Connect the FRS radio to your car's 12 volt or USB port; otherwise the battery will be depleted during the drive and important information will be missed.

If you don't have a FRS radio, borrow one, or purchase a radio (\$30) from an outdoor/sporting stores or Amazon. The radio must be clearly identified as "FRS".

Set your radio to channel 11, no tone control. We're going to keep it simple. If Ch 11 is busy, we'll move to an adjacent vacant channel.
